Disco - a September disco is planned. Cinema nights are planned to be reintroduced – maybe KS1 and KS2 separately? Christmas Fayre – 7th December? – local businesses will be invited. Bob a Job will be set up for the new school year in September – each child can raise £5.00 during the course of the year doing little jobs for friends and family.</p>	
<p>Future Fundraisers</p> <p>Textile bin collection recently raised £54.</p> <p>Magpie collection next week – old dvds, CDs, phones etc. parents should have this in mind when clearing out at home.</p> <p>Match-funding – JT has been approached by Sarah Allen, who has offered to provide signs to advertise the school fete on her Estate Agents boards. JT has also asked her about the possibility of match funding – she is looking into it.</p> <p>Drum Beat – a newsletter that is issued to army quarters – could be a possible place to advertise our events.</p> <p>Summer Fete – Timing 10-2.00pm Stalls – Inflatarama – 5/6 inflatables. Children will be charged about £2.50 and wear a colour-coded band for 30 minutes play. PTA gets % of profit. Bar open from 11.00am BBQ – straight forward - sausages and burgers. Tuck Shop – sweets, soft drinks etc. Ice creams (3 flavours), face painting, raffle, bows stall, splat the rat, nerf gun alley, crafts, lego, guess number of jelly beans in a jar, aeroplane competition, flip a coin, tatoos, crockery break, coconut shy. LF suggested a token system, whereby visitors buy on entrance and use them to pay for activities /stalls.
