

Another highly successful academic year has passed us by and, on behalf of the PTA Committee, I would like to take this opportunity to thank the Governors, Teaching Staff, Parents and Guardians and our Children for all your continued support. Without which the PTA would not have been able to run successful fund raising events this year. So, I hear you ask, what did we raise? Well we managed to raise a staggering grand total of £5222, which includes over £200 from our textile recycling bin, £750 from Christmas events, a whopping £107 from the Sports Day Teas & Coffee Stalls and an amazing £1986 at the Summer Fete.
